DESCRIPTION

Being linked to a plurality of legal systems, such disputes might be settled in different fora (state courts, arbitral tribunals, international courts, etc.) and on the basis of different laws. This gives rise to peculiar problems, the solution of which requires a specialised knowledge for those involved in their prevention and management, be they counsels, in-house counsels, legal officers, managers, government officials, or scholars interested in the phenomenon for scientific reasons.

The GLAM Master program aims at providing students with such knowledge from a holistic and entrepreneurial perspective, focusing not only on international arbitration but also delving into litigation before state and international courts.
